Call To Order-

Band Booster President, Mark Cosner, calls the meeting to order at 7:02 pm in the IVC Band Room.

Matt shows Toluca parade video at start of the meeting.

Budget- 2012-2013 is distributed and overview given by Mark. It is suggested that the budget be available on Boosters website. John motions approving the 2012-2013 budget, Lisa seconds, the motion carries, none opposed.

Dan Terpstra is recognized and applauded for preparing the 2012-2013 budget and his past years of service.

Equipment Purchase- Boosters have an opportunity to purchase year-old instruments from Dubuque Colts Drum and Bugle Corp at a large discount. An anonymous donor has provided funding for a marimba purchase. Matt recommends purchasing 2 euphoniums for \$1500 each. Matt demonstrates a euphonium and highlights the advantages of the newer instruments as replacements for trombones. Mark notes that the Colts have offered to donate other equipment like mallets. There is an opportunity to develop a relationship with the Colts for future purchases and donations. Alanda motions approving the instrument purchase, Deb seconds, the motion carries, none opposed. Equipment will be picked up September 12th.

Fundraising- Summer Camp earned \$9000 this year, \$3.40/hour, 25% less than last year. Discontinuing participation is discussed. Issues about replacement fundraisers and availability of work opportunities to many volunteers are raised. Problems with security and safety encountered this year are mentioned. It is noted that organizing Summer Camp workers and logistics is difficult and if people want to work it they can free-lance and keep track of their own hours and pay. Gina motions that Boosters no longer participate in Summer Camp, Chris seconds, the motion carries, none opposed.

Kroger Cart earned \$1500 this year, \$15/hour. Boosters should continue and expand this fundraiser and look for other opportunities as all ideas are welcome. Bussing tables at Castaways is suggested.

Band Director Update- Matt thanks volunteers for Band Bash, Phantom Regiment, Band Camp, and Toluca parade. He also thanks an anonymous donor of bus transportation.

Matt covers schedules for upcoming competitions: Morton/Pontiac, Limestone, Geneseo and BOA. He also suggests getting gifts for JH students participating in homecoming show.
