Call To Order-

Band Booster President, Mark Cosner, calls the meeting to order at 7:04 pm in the IVC Band Room.

Secretary Report-

Mark Cosner asks if there are any changes for the 4Dec12 minutes. No corrections are needed. Mary Totten motions approving meeting minutes, John seconds, the motion carries, none opposed.

Treasurer Report-

Mary Totten presents updated budget. Mary notes the \$864.72 working balance. Pam Orton motions approving treasurer report, Alanda Hunt seconds, the motion carries, none opposed.

New Business-

John Rotherham, Custom Fundraising Solutions, presents a mattress fund raising opportunity. General population marketing statistics indicate that 14.8 % are considering mattress purchase and 10% purchase. His plan is to hold sale in IVC HS cafeteria. 62% of profits go to the program. Distributions for student accounts could be done by Boosters. He suggests that a fundraiser of IVC Band's size, 102 kids, could net \$4k-\$7k. He could place 18 sample sets in cafeteria. Delivery occurs in 1-2 weeks. Restonic and Southerland brands are offered and include 2-25 year non-prorated warranties. Planning would require a 1 month lead time for selling and entail 2 meetings prior to sale. Prices would range from \$199 -\$1499. Delivery and setup are not included but available for extra fee. Profits of \$50, \$75, and \$100 per mattress depend on type of mattress sold. Individual incentives are available. CFS offers free layaway. Suggested that fundraiser takes place March 2nd, 9-5 pm. This date would coincide with the Winter Band Concert March 3rd and Trivia Night the evening of March 2nd. Richwoods HS sold about 47 mattresses. Promotional ideas include newspaper article and newspaper advertisement. A video trailer for Town Theater is suggested.
