Call To Order-

Band Booster President, Mark Cosner, calls the meeting to order at 7:04 pm in the IVC Band Room.

Secretary Report-

Mark Cosner asks if there are any changes for the 12Mar13 minutes. No corrections, other than previously emailed, are needed. Lisa Rogers motions approving the meeting minutes, Alanda Hunt seconds, the motion carries, none opposed.

Treasurer Report-
