Call to Order-

Band Booster President, Mark Cosner, calls the meeting to order at 7:07 pm in the IVC Band Room.

Secretary Report-

Mark Cosner asks if there are any changes for the 9Apr13 minutes. No corrections are needed Alanda Hunt motions approving the meeting minutes, Leigh Bowen seconds, and the motion carries, none opposed.

Treasurer Report-

Mark Cosner presents updated budget for Treasurer Mary Totten. Mark notes the negative (\$1,247.63) working balance. The waiving of an estimated \$2,000 San Diego bus bill is still being discussed by district. Connie Iverson motions approving treasurer report, Lisa Rogers seconds, the motion carries, none opposed.

New Business-

Why is Fundraising Necessary? flyer from last year presented by Mark Cosner. This flyer will be updated with current information.

Connie Iverson revisits students paying for reeds, sticks as previously discussed. Rental charges for band instruments discussed.

Cardinal's game deadline for payment is about 3 weeks before the August 6th game. The goal is for fundraising profit to pay for the students. 7th and 8th grade students will not be invited this time but alumni will be invited will be asked to pay their own ticket cost unless fundraising profit will allow for covering their costs.

Kroger Cart Fundraiser Thursday, Friday and Saturday during summer camp May 23rd-25th. Pepsi trailer will not be used this time. Boosters will set up in front to the north side of the front door which will hopefully improve visibility and translate to increased sales. Two adults, two students or all adults if enough available will work in shifts, possibly 2-7pm 3-8pm 6-9pm. Band musicians should be scheduled so they can cover the entire event especially from 7-9pm. Mark suggests a performance video when band is not playing. Twelve to sixteen chairs will be set up instead of the 30 chairs last year. Butterfly Pork Chops, Brats and Hot Dogs will be offered. Flyer will be made for local businesses to promote employee lunches. Lemon shakeups are being considered. Trying to get Pepsi products donated. It is suggested that Karyn Terpstra, who is organizing a June 2nd luau for local businesses to thank them for their past support, could include a cart flyer with her luau flyer. Flyer could be ready in about a day. It is suggested to set up early Thursday morning as campers arriving and serve breakfast items. Tips for musicians can be pooled with percentage going into general fund and then split evenly among volunteers into student accounts. Mark notes that historically summer camp was split 50/50 between student and general fund. John Gleason motions approving a 50/50 distribution of funds between student accounts and general fund, Connie Iverson 2nds, the motion carries, none opposed.

Band Camp update provided by Co-Chair Karen Pitts indicates that chaperones are lined up. Mark requests that Karen and Chris Hart create a checklist of activities for chairing the band camp for future chair person's reference. Chaperone numbers are discussed. Matt Chapman can discuss chaperone issues with chairs at another time. Mr. Chapman's main concern is safety.

Phantom Regiment arriving July 9th at 4 am and will leave about 5pm. Boosters need to provide a lunch or dinner meal for them. Mr. Chapman requires volunteers a menu and publicity. Students should come from noon- 4pm to watch their professional rehearsal. They will perform in Metamora that evening.

Band maintenance days are June 1st and May 25th from 9am until the jobs are done. Adults and students are needed to help clean, hang pictures, paint and organize.
