Secretary Report

Chris Featherstone asked if there were any changes needed for the September Minutes. Steve Reginald made a motion to approve the September Minutes, Eric Morr seconded. The motion carried. None opposed.

Treasurer Report

Treasurer, Eric Morr, reported that we are down on funds, around \$10,000 relative to last year. We are going to restate some budget line items. We expected to have \$8,000 of income for band uniforms, and we will likely not meet that. We have about \$34,000 of at large funds, but need to keep an eye on spending as well as figure out how to make up some of the income. We are currently reconciled through July, August and September.

Band camp fees of \$5,600 are still outstanding. This amount is after the scholarship funds have been accounted for.

We are planning to do a new fee schedule for next year. State and Federal Income taxes will be coming up as well. Kelly Welch made a motion to approve the Treasurer's Report, Steve Reginald seconded. Motion passed.

Old Business

IVC jackets

There were ink issues with respect to the jackets. Deb Reginald reported that the fronts were done, but the backs were the wrong color. The backs had to be reordered. They should be done by ISU, possibly by Thursday.

ISU Competition: Matt reports there is an updated schedule. Sherard is not in our class, as they decided not to perform. If we make finals, we will make a quick reservation at Pizza Ranch, and then return to stadium by 4 p.m. There will be a parent bus.
